

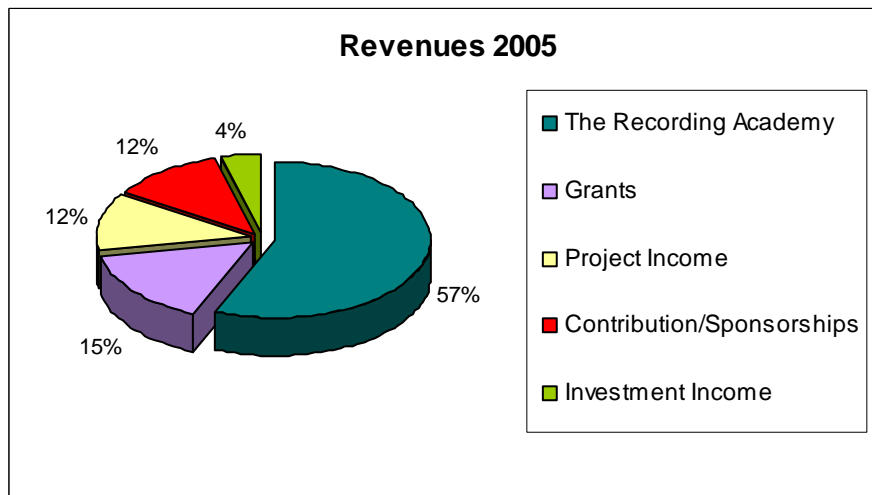
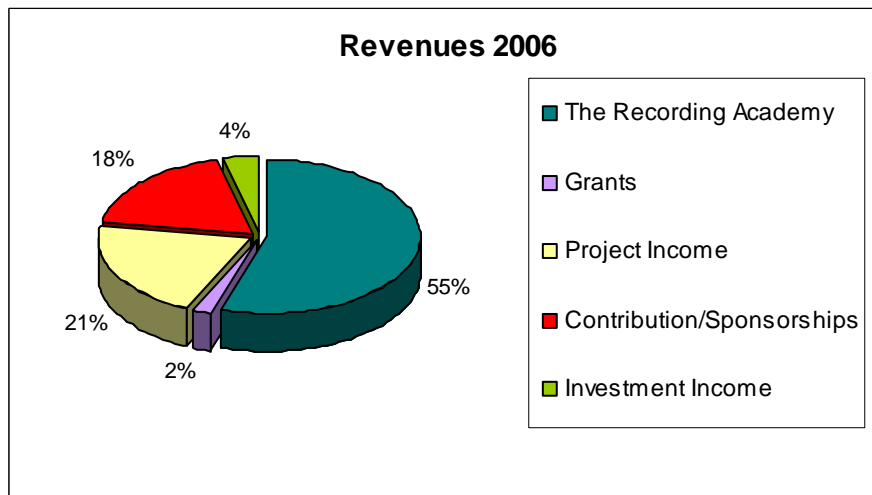

The GRAMMY Foundation has a diverse range of revenue streams. This includes project income from fundraising events such as Starry Night, the GRAMMY Charity Online Auctions, and an annual Holiday Giving Campaign. Additionally, the GRAMMY Foundation enjoys sponsorship revenues from companies such as Anschutz Entertainment Group, the Entertainment Industry Foundation, Epiphone, Gibson Foundation, and other contributed income. Support also comes from the National Academy of Recording Arts and Sciences, investment income and grants.



The GRAMMY Foundation offers educational program services such as the Gibson/Baldwin GRAMMY Jazz Ensembles, GRAMMY Signature, Schools, GRAMMY Career Day, GRAMMY Pro Sessions, GRAMMY SoundChecks and GRAMMY Camp. It also produces preservation and advancement initiatives including grants for archive, preservation and research projects, Living Histories that document the stories of our cultural heritage, and the Entertainment Law Initiative.
